Dear Minister,

I write in relation to pedestrian safety on Campbelltown Road in St Andrews and Bow Bowing.

Numerous constituents have contacted me to lament the lack of footpaths along Campbelltown Road. Residents have also pointed out there is no safe way to cross Campbelltown Road between Bow Bowing and St Andrews.

The following solutions have been proposed:

- Footpaths to be constructed along the section of Campbelltown Road between Ben Lomond Road and Central Park Drive;
- A pedestrian overbridge connecting Bow Bowing and St Andrews.

Given the lack of footpath and crossing facilities on Campbelltown Road, I would anticipate current pedestrian numbers to be relatively low.

It would be unacceptable for the Liberal Government to cite low pedestrian numbers as justification for not fixing an obvious safety issue.

As Campbelltown Road is classified as a State road, it falls on the Liberal Government to keep pedestrians and motorists safe.

Your advice on the matters raised above would be greatly appreciated.
