I refer to the consultation process for changes to Hurlstone Agricultural High School that were announced on 9 December 2020.

It is outrageous and appalling that the Liberal Government requires the community to provide feedback on the changes to Hurlstone by 23 December 2020.

In my experience, the community is already cynical of the Government's approach to 'community consultation'. Releasing plans for Hurlstone when everyone is distracted by preparations for the holiday season only justifies the community's cynicism.

In fact, releasing information about changes to Hurlstone Agricultural High School weeks out from Christmas is disgraceful.

Your immediate response to my request for the consultation process to be extended until at least 1 March 2021 would be appreciated.
