Dear Minister,

I write again in relation to the ongoing commuter parking crisis at Edmondson Park Station.

Whilst my constituents are likely to be relieved by the recent announcement that 2000 extra spaces will be built at the station, they are understandably tearing their hair out in frustration that there will be further delays before the new car park is built.

Unfortunately, there has been very little transparency from the Liberal Government in relation to the delivery of the extra spaces, including temporary measures to alleviate the parking crisis.

My constituents rightly want to know when the 2000 extra spaces will be built, where the carpark will be located and when a temporary carpark will be available. Last month, I asked a Question on Notice (LA Question 2161) in a bid to get answers and avail community concern.

The answer to my detailed question was unacceptable: "This information is publicly available".

This appalling response reveals the lack of respect this Liberal Government has for commuters in south-west Sydney. My community does not deserve such contempt.

As a matter of urgency, please provide detailed answers on the following:

- a. When will construction start on the 2,000 extra spaces?
- b. When will the spaces be open and ready to use?
- c. Where will the 2,000 spaces be located?
- d. When will the temporary car park be ready for use?
- e. Where will the temporary car park be located?
- f. How many spaces will be available in the temporary car park?
